

Parent Code of Conduct

The Parent Code of Conduct sets the expected behaviour of parents, guardians and visitors when on nursery premises or when engaging with nursery staff, other parents and children. The Parent Code of Conduct is established to ensure a positive working relationship between the nursery staff, parents, guardians and the general community.

Expected Behaviour towards Staff

The nursery welcomes polite and courteous visitors. Violent, abusive or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated. Acts of harassment, discrimination, physical or verbal abuse either directly or indirectly will not be tolerated.

Expected Behaviour towards all Children

It is the right of each individual child to be treated with respect. Anti-discriminatory behaviour will be expected at all times. Adults are encouraged to contribute towards a happy and caring environment showing respect and applying a positive approach to all individuals. Appropriate language must be maintained at all times whilst on nursery premises.

Expected Behaviour from Parents towards Other Parents

Parents are expected to act as positive role models. Acts of harassment, discrimination, physical or verbal abuse either directly or indirectly will not be tolerated.

Consequences

Refusal to act in a way which adheres to the Parent Code on Conduct could result in a permanent loss of your nursery place.
