These core British values are promoted through daily play provision and learning experiences in accordance with the EYFS Framework.

However, with all rights come responsibilities, for example, free speech that advocates intolerance, hatred or harm towards others will not be tolerated. Everyone has a responsibility to be vigilant of and act upon any causes of concern. Goldsmiths College Nursery will continue to protect all children and staff from groups of people with messages of violent extremism and ideologies designed to manipulate the vulnerable and young. The nursery will follow and adhere to its safeguarding procedures accordingly.

Groups or individuals may include, but not be restricted to, the following: Far Right, Neo Nazis, White Supremacist, and Extreme Islamic Ideology, Irish Nationalist or Loyalist Paramilitary groups.

Goldsmiths College Nursery is clear that the exploitation and radicalisation, of parents or practitioners displaying any signs of these viewpoints, will be viewed as a safeguarding concern and will be referred to the appropriate safeguarding agencies.
